- 1. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm

- 3. NEW BUSINESS:
 - 3.1 Establishment of a policy to trim the large trees in the Greenbelt. It was reported that a policy has to be established on how the Association should be dealing with the large trees that are growing in the Greenbelt next to or near existing homes. Michael Dwyer stated that there was an agreement in place with the State of Hawaii DLNR Dept. in which the Association will be able to cut back the trees 30 feet into the Greenbelt. There is concern that homeowners or renters will not contact NECA until a large tree or branch falls causing property damage. The Committee will continue to work on this problem.
 - 3.2 There was a discussion on problems with soil erosion from storm drains into the Greenbelt.
 - 3.3 There was a discussion on hikers and hunters crossing into the Greenbelt from an open area at the end of Hapaki St. we have received some complaints from residents in this area about pig hunters who park on the street and walk into the Greenbelt to hunt.
